## Means of verification

For this milestone, challenges for network development and task performance were reported by NEFERTITI network leaders and were translated into specific needs. The challenges were reported during the workshop on key factors for network development at the annual meeting in Toulouse (June 2018) and delivered through the draft dynamic actions plans (DAP) of each thematic network (September 2018). In an excel file, these challenges were structured per key factor for network development. These challenges were then translated into possible needs, and a first attempt was made to define who can assist in meeting these needs (either the networks themselves or the NEFERTITI work packages). These needs were summarized in a word document in which the different needs were attributed to the different WPs. Both the excel and word document were sent to the WP leaders for input and verification and can be used to further specify the manuals, guidelines, and training that should be provided by the different WPs to the network leaders.
