The overall objective of the knowledge exchange meetings is to improve networking among innovation actors in order to boost relevant knowledge exchange. That given, knowledge exchange meetings specifically aim at exchanging ready to practice knowledge among hub coaches, network leaders and innovation actors, between hubs at network level. Exchange will also take place between hub coaches, network leaders and demo-farmers of different networks. This is intended to foster the sharing of knowledge and cross-fertilisation among networks and between networks, increasing peer-to-peer learning among hub coaches and demo-farmers, connecting and networking demo-farmers with other innovation actors. These events aim at improving the demonstration capacities and the uptake of project results and innovative practices delivered under RUR-11 projects and also steer the EU networks of demo-farmers and their activities.

Task 2.3: “EU networks knowledge exchange meetings for coaches and demo-farmers” will, therefore, organise, three transnational knowledge exchange events, which are foreseen to take place in years 2,3 and 4. Every year, these events will be tailored to the needs identified by demo farmers and hub coaches in regards to knowledge exchange. In year 1, the knowledge exchange meeting will focus on the foundations of knowledge exchange in the context of the NEFERTITI project and on relevant technical themes for each network and sector.
