Task 2.4 “EU networks field Cross-Visits for coaches and demo-farmers” focuses on the organisation of three field Cross-Visits (2/3 days long) per each NEFERTITI network. Cross-visits have as objective to exchange experiences and knowledge between demo-farmers from different European countries and disseminate best practices both on technical questions of the thematic topic and on the organisation of effective demo activities. These visits are focused on learning between national/regional hubs of a given network and intend to improve the skills of hub coaches and demo-farmers. In the light of this, best practices recommendations developed under WP1 will also be disseminated at the cross-visits.

For this specific milestone a methodology for cross-visits was developed, in close collaboration between WP2 and WP5, and built on the successful cross-visit methodology developed in AgriSpin project. The resulting document is attached below. Monitoring and evaluation tools are foreseen as a way of guaranteeing continuous improvement and, therefore, this is an evolving document, to be adapted throughout the duration of the project.
