#### 10 Networks

NEFERTITI established **45 regional clusters** (hubs) that bring together a wide range of demo-farmers and other innovation actors working on a given topic. These hubs are organised in **10 thematic networks**, representing key concerns in the agricultural sector in Europe.

More than 250 demo events are organised per year within the context of the project, spread across 13 EU countries. These events put together more than 12 000 participants per year, with at least 50% of farmers.
