This milestone is based on the realisation of D1.2 Good practice for farm demonstrations. These good practices were presented to the network leaders and hub coaches during the Annual Meeting in Alberese (Italy- February, 26th -28th). During the annual meeting, workshops were organised in which each network was able to discuss these best practices and to use and tailor them to their use for the organisation of a demo event of their choice. The networks and hub coaches were asked to complete an evaluation sheet, and information that came out of these was already taken into account in D1.2.

However, this tailoring of the best practices to the networks' needs is an ongoing process that will continue during the course of the upcoming demo campaigns. Both the evaluation of the DAPs and the close collaboration with WP5 (in which also the WP1 contributors are involved) will highly contribute to this process. The analysis of the DAPs and the use of the M&E tools developed in WP5 will allow to further refine the networks' needs regarding the best practices.

Further, from June 2019 on, the networks start organising their cross visits. Assistance will be offered to them to organise them and use the best practices tailored to their needs. The M&E exercises performed during these cross visits will also further contribute to our understanding of the Networks' needs for tailored best practices.

Finally, although not promised in the grant agreement, the best practices will be further developed into an (online) farm demo training kit, including a demo event design guide, M&E tools, rich stories of demo events, a virtual demo design guide, ... Further we will organise training sessions that extend the limits of the project, for example, by organising workshops for other interested projects (other projects already showed their interest in this).
