#### Objectives of the common agenda

The objective to set up a common agenda with the SCAR SWG AKIS following a requirement clearly expressed in the call to which NEFERTITI proposal was submitted (Horizon 2020 – Societal Challenge 2- RUR12 – 2017):

"They should look for synergies with the inventory of demonstration farms and best demonstration approaches delivered under topic RUR-11-2016 and coordinate their strategy with the SCAR- AKIS Strategic Working Group."

It has been agreed with the co-chair of the SWG AKIS (Aniko Juhasz – Ministry of Agriculture of Hungary) and the EC Policy Officer in charge of the SWG AKIS (Inge Van Oost – DG AGRI – Unit B2) that NEFERTITI will be presented to the SCAR SWG AKIS <u>on an annual basis</u>.

No presentations have been made so far in 2018 as the SWG AKIS focuses its activities in finishing the work engaged to terminate the 4<sup>th</sup> Mandate.

Moreover, as the SWG AKIS 4<sup>th</sup> mandate will end by March 2019 and as the 5<sup>th</sup> mandate of the SWG AKIS should first be debated in the SCAR Steering Group meeting (November 2018) before its official approval by the SCAR plenary (December 2018), no formal plans have been scheduled for future presentation.

Nevertheless a presentation will be confirmed on an annual basis, before or after every Demonstration campaign of NEFERTITI in year 2, 3 and 4 of the project.
